Cinnamon, French Vanilla, and Butterscotch topped with walnuts, cherries, whipped cream and a double ribbon on chocolate and caramel sauce. This is the perfect party dessert served in a really cool martini type glass. My personal favorite was the Dessert Bites, a combination of deep fried brownie pieces and fried banana's foster bites at the base of a Bassetts French Vanilla Ice Cream Mountain drizzled in caramel sauce. Those crispy, chewy bites were really excellent. This is the kind of dessert great for sharing, and even better kept all to yourself. Finally we have the classic Brownie Sundae, made with freshly baked rich
